

EUPATI CH - Advisory Board Description

This description (version 5, English, date 24.05.2022) provides information on the composition of the EUPATI CH Advisory Board and its purpose and roles. This is a 'living document' and should be updated by the Executive Board as necessary and should be reviewed at the Annual meeting of the association members.

1. Aim of the Advisory Board

The Advisory Board (AB) shall provide non-binding expert advice and guidance on planning, fundraising and national dissemination activities of EUPATI CH.

2. **Composition**

Membership of the Advisory Board (AB) remains open to all patients, patient advocates, patient organisations, consumer organisations, academics, institutions, university hospitals, healthcare associations, industry representatives, companies, government agencies representatives, regulatory authorities, medical journalists, and anyone interested.

The Advisory Board members should have experience in either patient advocacy, public relations and aspects of medicines R&D and health care and ideally have a strong network of personal and professional contacts.

A request to become an Advisory Board member of EUPATI CH shall be sent to the Executive Board by sending an email to the secretariat (<u>secretariat@eupati.ch</u>) indicating the intent and commitment to support the association.

The exact composition, size, appointing, function, and term in office should be determined by the Executive Board by a consensus vote considering diversity of the composition.

The chairperson of the AB will be elected by consensus of the AB among its members

All positions shall be held in a voluntary capacity.

3. **Roles and functioning**

The Advisory Board may be called in disputes within EUPATI CH or within the Executive Board.

The advice given and the consequences taken based on this advice will be clearly documented to ensure utmost transparency.



Specific roles and responsibilities of the AB:

- to support the Executive Board in setting the medium-long term strategic priorities for the EUPATI CH association
- to provide general guidance and recommendations regarding scientific, technical, and ethical aspects of the activities, including advice for the local context (legal)
- to advise the Executive Board on the communication and dissemination strategy
- to identify in the EUPATI CH dissemination activities any critical step or missing element that may represent a risk for the realisation of the activity
- to consult additional experts as necessary, and in agreement with the Executive Board
- to promote and support the organisation of events
- to propose and support initiatives to promote PI and increase awareness of the community

4. Meetings

The Advisory Board will meet at least once a year. In addition to the meetings, email exchanges and/or telephone conferences can take place on specific issues requiring immediate advice.

The Advisory Board Chair will be invited to attend meetings of the EUPATI CH Executive Board.

The Advisory Board will be invited to attend meetings of EUPATI CH on specific thematic areas.
